

Nayara Energy operationalizes its second greenfield railfed fuel depot in India at Pali, Rajasthan

- Commissioned Vapour Recovery Unit at the depot with unique hybrid technology
- Extends community support by providing classroom furniture and completed repair works for Sr. Secondary School building at Chotila village in Pali District

July 08, 2022, Pali, Rajasthan: Nayara Energy, a downstream energy and petrochemicals company of international scale, today announced that it has operationalized its second greenfield rail-fed fuel depot at Pali in Rajasthan. The world-class, fully automated rail-fed depot was constructed in ~2,00,000-man days with nil Lost Time Injury (LTI) and will help enhance safety performance and reduce VOC (volatile organic compounds) emission at Nayara Energy. The depot, which is uniquely positioned, will cater to the requirements of customers as well as business partners in and around the Rajasthan state.

Spread on approx. 60 acres, the depot has a capacity of over 29,000 kilolitres (KL) of products which will be supplied from Nayara Energy's refinery at Vadinar, Gujarat. In line with its vision to develop the community alongside, Nayara Energy has provided classroom furniture and completed repair works for the Sr. Secondary School building at Chotila village in Pali District. The company also completed the repair works in the local medical dispensary at Chotila village, contributing towards the healthcare services in the region.

With a focus on promoting a safer and cleaner depot operations, Nayara Energy has also commissioned a vapour recovery unit with a unique hybrid technology.

Speaking on the occasion, **Alois Virag, CEO Nayara Energy said**, "The addition of our second depot in Pali is in line with our commitment to creating world-class assets in a sustainable manner to fuel India's growing energy demands. Moreover, this will further strengthen accessibility and supply of fuel across Rajasthan, while enhancing safety performance and improve the environmental footprint at Nayara Energy."

"It also provides us an opportunity to further strengthen our commitment towards the community. By providing adequate facilities around the depot Nayara Energy will create a transformative change in the Pali District," **he further added**.
